Hello SIPP Partners/Potential Partners:

We hope you are well and doing OK in this time of war. Our hearts are with you.

West Bank Violence Relief Grant Applications. Sustainable Israeli Palestinian Projects (SIPP, www.sippprojects.org) is offering one-time relief mini-grants targeting programs that address the impact of settler violence in the West Bank Palestinian communities. We are now accepting brief, informal applications from organizations that do this work in the hope that such projects may help staunch violence and build the trust that is essential for any future peace.

As SIPP has limited funds, we are reaching out to ask you to apply and/or share this announcement with other organizations that are involved in reducing or eliminating settler violence.

If you are interested in applying for grant funds from SIPP, please get back to us via email **by June 1, 2026**, telling us:

- Amount requested (up to USD \$2,500)
- Project details, including target audiences and expected outcomes
- Project time frame
- How the project will assist in addressing the impacts of and/or reducing settler violence
- How your project provides opportunities for multi-cultural connection to help build trust
- Geographic focus
- Organization designated to receive funds (must be an organization, not an individual)
- Organization and individuals that will manage the project
- Organization or project website or other online presence
- How you will keep SIPP informed of project activities during the duration of the grant

Priority will be given to projects that advance environmental sustainability (such as protecting water access or agricultural lands) and/or those that foster solidarity between Palestinian and Israeli communities.

Email applications are **due by June 1, 2026**.

SIPP plans to make selections by June 26, with an August 1 start date for projects, with a project end date of December 31, 2026. A final report will be due in mid-January 2027.

NOTE - SIPP is flexible on scheduling.
